

Palmers Green Shopping Area Regeneration and Improvement Questionnaire

Enfield Council has agreed to a joint request from Palmers Green Residents and its Business Association to work in partnership to develop a long term plan to enhance our town centre. As a first stage they want to hear what residents, traders and others who have a stake in the area think.

The area currently being considered runs along Green Lanes from the Hedge Lane junction to the Library / Town Hall junction and up Aldermans Hill as far as the park gates, including the Triangle.

We believe that the area can be a much better place in which to live, work and study. It can be an area with a higher quality of life, a cleaner, healthier and more attractive environment, a stronger local economy, a better standard of infrastructure and improved public services.

We now need to determine exactly how to go about achieving this. All ideas will be welcomed and considered by a working group.
